

ALBANY GUN SHOW RULES AND INFORMATION

- PLEASE READ -

GENERAL TABLE POLICY AND DISCOUNT SCHEDULE

1. Vendors are limited to maximum of 16 tables with the exception of renting no-show tables at show time to fill vacant spaces.
2. Vendors who rent tables at both shows are considered 'preferred' vendors and will have both the number of tables and location of tables honored when possible. If changes are made in the number of tables rented it may require a change in location. Vendors who skip shows (participate in one ARPC show every year) will be given preference over new vendors and will be given their prior table(s) assignment when possible.
3. ARPC Gun Show management reserves the right to reassign table(s) location at anytime prior or during the show.
4. The following table discount pricing is available on all tables. A 10% discount for early table sign-up if reservations and payment made by the deadline noted on the vendor application. An additional 10% discount will be applied to all early table reservations for vendors who rent a 16 table island.
5. All vendors, who rent tables, must have a current vendor application on file, follow all show rules and are prohibited from subletting any of their tables to other non-registered vendors selling or displaying merchandise at the show.
6. ARPC has a limited number of tables that are for non-profit groups at the gun show. Tables are assigned on a first come first serve basis and priority will be given to local non-profit groups before considering 'out of the region' non-profit groups.

RULES

1. All Federal, State and Local laws must be obeyed at all times.
2. All transactions are to take place INSIDE the gun show building. NO EXCEPTIONS.
3. To prevent accidental discharge **NO** loaded firearms are allowed in the gun show, including persons with concealed handgun permit. **Except armed security provided by show management or law enforcement officers.**
4. **All** firearms must have the actions tied rendering them inoperable. Ties with different colors will be supplied showing which guns belong to vendors, walk-ins, or have been sold. This is necessary to help prevent gun thefts.
5. Loose cartridges are not allowed near firearms. Any dummy rounds must have primers removed and holes drilled through the side.
6. All firearms must have magazines removed and actions tied open.
7. Knives must be sheathed, unless they are not readily accessible by the public. Glass display cases are recommended to display knives.
8. **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.**
9. Minors under 18 must be accompanied by an adult.
10. No audio or visual equipment allowed without permission of the gun show management.
11. Show Security reserves the right to inspect any packages, containers or personal belongings entering or leaving the show.
12. All self-defense spray must be in sealed packages.
13. All lasers and stun devices must have the battery removed or not be readily available to the public.
14. Vendors must adhere to vehicle parking guidelines. All RV's must park in designated RV parking and pay a parking fee if spending the night. Arrangements can be made for overnight RV parking by calling Linn County fairgrounds at 541-926-4314 8 AM to 5 PM Mon-Fri.
15. **Failure to keep your table space occupied and open for business during the open hours of the show, without Management approval, may cause loss of your space at future Albany Gun Shows. Failure to show up without contacting ARPC prior to show may result in rent forfeiture.**
16. Vendors and Staff will be supplied with badges. These must be worn while in the gun show.
17. Table contents must be 90% gun or knife related items.
18. No pets allowed inside Linn County exhibit halls.
19. No soliciting, other than private parties trying to sell their own firearms, is permitted, on the gun show floor. All soliciting, other than the noted exception, is permitted only at vendor or comp tables.

INFORMATION

1. Setup for the show will be Friday, 12 to 9pm and Saturday, 7AM until show opening at 9AM. Note: **Failure to occupy the space by show opening without prior contact will result in loss of table rent.**
2. The Gun Show is open to the public from 9AM to 5PM Saturday and 9AM to 4PM Sunday. Vendors will be allowed in the building at 7AM Saturday and 8AM Sunday.
3. Donuts and coffee will be available at 8:00AM both days.
