PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Members of Albany Rifle & Pistol Club, Looking for a place to shoot I became a member of ARPC in December of 1996.

In March of 1999, I volunteered to take over the vacant treasurers job and was elected by a vote of the members present at that general meeting.

In November 2003 the board has been the target of several insinuations calling into question our and my honesty.

As I do not have a business that uses the club for personal profit, nor do any other current club officers, I tend to discount the "cookie jar" JAB.

(Q) - Once you became the treasurer of the club did you update and improve the monthly financial reports so that all could see the finances of the club easily?

(Q) - When you learned that Debi Parker, in an email, had called your honesty and integrity into question, did you ask her why and what was her answer?

(Q) - You're telling me that Debi Parker called your honesty and integrity into question without one shred of evidence?

(Q) - In view of your excellent service to the club as treasurer and president, you and your wife's past employment history, the bonding requirement - that is the lowest and most reprehensible conduct I have ever heard of. Thank you for your valuable service to our club. I value it highly.

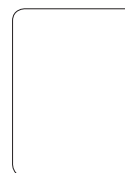
