Main Range Safety

MAIN RANGE SAFETY

After moving our office to the north end of the Main Range, it has come to our attention that many members have forgotten or neglected to follow rules of the main range. Remember that eye and ear protection is **MANDATORY** in all shooting areas on the premises even if you are a spectator. During a cease-fire on the Main Range, actions are to be open and no one is allowed to be between the yellow safety line and the red muzzle line. It is quite unsettling to walk downrange and look up to see someone fiddling with their firearm (even an unloaded firearm) as it is pointed at the target area **AND YOU!** Please remember these rules and remind fellow members and guests of them. If you have a problem with a member or guest try to inform them of the rules. If that doesn't solve the problem, **get the member's name** and alert a club staff member, Range Officer or Executive Board member who will follow-up with the member. **Without their name we cannot follow up.**

ARPC CLUB FFL



Ever since the Gun Control Act of 1968 was passed, the manufacture and sale of firearms has only been possible by those in possession of a Federal Firearms License (FFL). As a club benefit to our members, ARPC acquired a Federal Firearm License from the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (BATFE) in July, 2010, thus insuring that our members always have means to receive firearms. We can legally accept firearms and conduct firearm transfers for our members and their guests. The club is charging a \$15 fee to accept and transfer a firearm for a club member and \$30 for a member's guest (non-member). Members who want to purchase a firearm and have it shipped to the club must first contact the office and obtain a copy of the club's FFL. Please call the office if you have any questions about purchasing or transferring firearms.

Our Constitution was amended by a majority vote at the November Annual Meeting. New members still pay the \$135 annual fee but from December 1, 2010 forward, all new memberships will renew based on the inception month.
