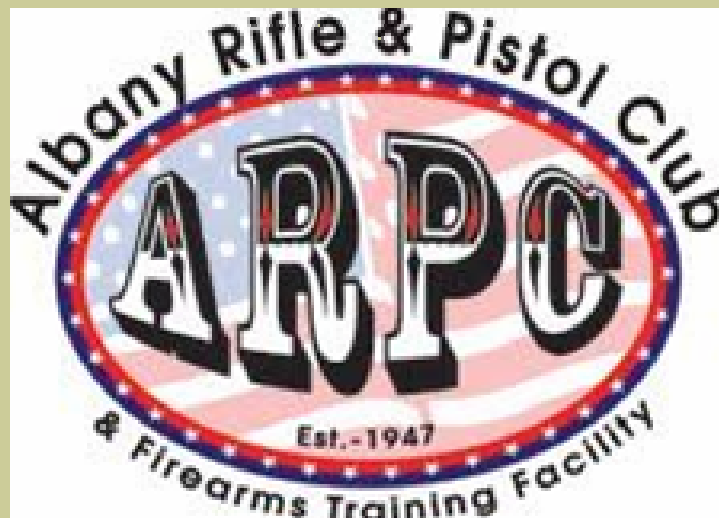
ARPC SPRING 2011 GUN SHOW VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

ARPC CLUB FFL



Ever since the Gun Control Act of 1968 was passed, the manufacture and sale of firearms has only been possible by those in possession of a Federal Firearms License (FFL). As a club benefit to our members, ARPC acquired a Federal Firearm License from the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (BATFE) in July, 2010, thus insuring that our members always have means to receive firearms. We can legally accept firearms and conduct firearm transfers for our members and their guests. The club is charging a \$15 fee to accept and transfer a firearm for a club member and \$30 for a member's guest (non-member). Members who want to purchase a firearm and have it shipped to the club must first contact the office and obtain a copy of the club's FFL. Please call the office if you have any questions about purchasing or transferring firearms.

the Executive Board or the club office at 541-491-3755. We hope you look forward to a fantastic 2011 shooting year!

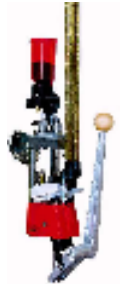
Handgun Reloading Class, Press and Bullets - All In One

HANDGUN RELOADING CLASS, PRESS AND BULLETS - ALL IN ONE

ARPC is holding a handgun reloading class on February 19th, 2011 at 9am that includes class instructions, reloading press, 500 brass shells, bullets, primers and powder.

The class covers:

1. Handgun reloading theory.
2. Setting up a new Lee Pro 1000 progressive reloading press (your choice of caliber).
3. Loading trial rounds and function testing, including measuring over a chronograph, single stage.
4. Changing press to progressive loading and reloading as many rounds as the student wants.



The instructor monitors all reloading and testing by students. When the student finishes the class they will leave the classroom with their reloading press, reloaded bullets and any unloaded components. The instructor for this class is Mike McCarter, ARPC Range Master and is limited to 8 students per class.

The cost of the class is \$320.00. Students must pay a \$170 deposit and specify the handgun caliber to reload by the 7th of February. This deposit covers the cost of the reloading press and is non-refundable.

Introduction to Basic Pistol Class

INTRODUCTION TO BASIC PISTOL CLASS

Are you frustrated with your handgun shooting and can't figure out why you can't hit the target consistently? Would you like to learn to shoot your handgun better? This class teaches you the basics behind handgun shooting. Shooting any gun is basic geometry, "keep the sights lined up while the gun goes bang" and it is just that simple. However, when talking about handguns there are many variables that affect the geometry.



The basic pistol class takes place on Saturday, January 29th from 9am to 12pm. This class covers handgun basics such as safety, handling, selection, grip, stance, sight alignment, trigger press and follow through.

Give Mike McCarter (541-619-0038) a call to register for the class, as it is limited to 12 people. Cost for the class is \$25 for ARPC club members and \$30 for non-members. Attendees need to bring; handgun, a holster that covers the trigger, strong belt, 150 rounds of ammunition and safety gear. Make sure you dress for the weather. 

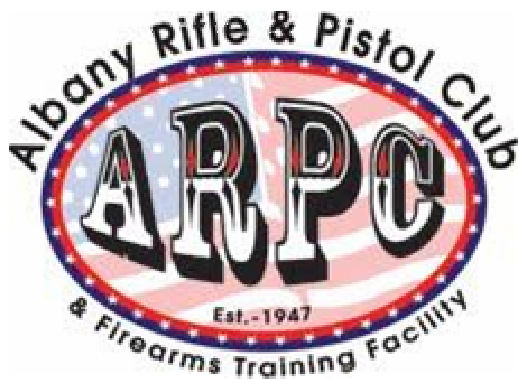
