Shipping a Gun to The Pro Shop?

The process to ship a gun to the ARPC Pro Shop improves again. You do not need to fill out any 'incoming firearm' paperwork in order to ship a gun to the ARPC Pro Shop, all you need to do is send a copy of our Federal Firearms License (FFL) to the person or company shipping the firearm to the club. In addition, we can now process firearm transfers six days a week, including Friday and Saturday. ARPC is using the internet to process firearm transfers. It still may take some extra time to complete transfers on the weekends due to increased sales throughout the state but at least we don't have the extended wait on the phone for the process.

FBI Releases 2010 Crime Report



"As firearms and ammunition maintained high-volume sales in 2010, the nation's crime rates continued to fall, a new report from the FBI shows. During 2010, violent crime declined for the fourth straight year, with an estimated six percent drop from 2009 figures.

The FBI statistics undermine a favorite argument of anti-gun groups and some mainstream media that "more guns equal more crime," especially when you consider that the decrease in violent crime over the past four years occurred at the same time that firearm sales were surging." (National Sports Shooting Association)

If you had the opportunity to purchase a new Glock handgun for \$425, would you? Two New Classes Debut at ARPC

On Sunday, October 2nd from 2pm to 5pm, we are holding a Ladies Intro & Practice USPSA session (United States Practical Shooting Association). This is a free class to introduce ladies to the sport of practical handgun shooting. The class will take place in Bay 3 on the north range and you do not have to sign up ahead of time, just show up! If you are new to the sport, contact Mike McCarter to find out what to bring to the class.

On Saturday, October 22nd, Basic Pistol 201 class is held in Bay 8 from 1pm to 3pm. This class moves you from the basics of pistol shooting to actual defensive pistol shooting in real life situations. Students will have an opportunity to draw from concealed carry positions and engage targets in a variety of situations. Participants should have a good basic knowledge of their firearm. Each person will need their own firearm, carry it concealed safely, 100 rounds of ammunition and safety gear (eye and ear protection). The goal is to add some stress to your shooting practice in a realistic way. Pre-registration is required and class cost is \$25. Call the club office to register or get answers to your questions, 541-491-3755. Remember that all classes are open to members and non-members of ARPC.
