
ARPC on Facebook

"House Passes National Right To Carry Bill...



Right-to-carry permit holders moved a step closer to being able to carry concealed firearms outside their home states when the U.S. House of Representatives passed H.R. 822, the National Right to Carry Reciprocity Act, by a vote of 272 to 154. NSSF supported the NRA-backed bill, which was introduced by Reps. Cliff Stearns (R-Fla.) and Heath Shuler (D-N.C.). A Senate version of the bill has yet to be introduced. Read more." NSSF

This is only the first step in opening up a National Right to Carry in the United States. It still needs to pass the Senate and be signed by the President. Please keep a close eye on this issue as it may require your help to get it passed. Mike
