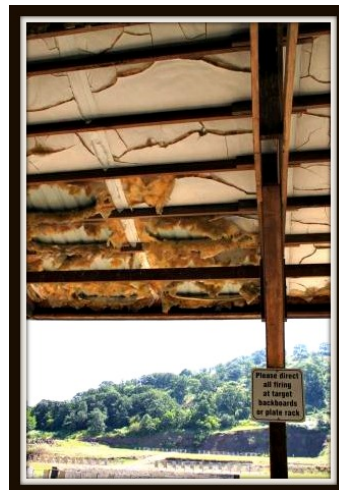

As of this newsletter we are about half way through with replacing the old shedding vapor barrier (new vapor barrier is rated at 19db noise reduction) on the main range. Projected improvements include new lighting, improved timers, eight new shooting benches, sound absorption panels on the back wall and center road improvements out to the 200 yard line. We thank you for your patience and understanding while this project takes place and the main range should be much nicer by this fall.

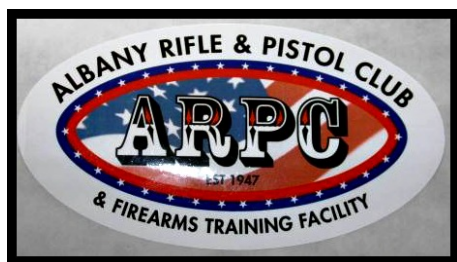


## East Range Parking Area Improved

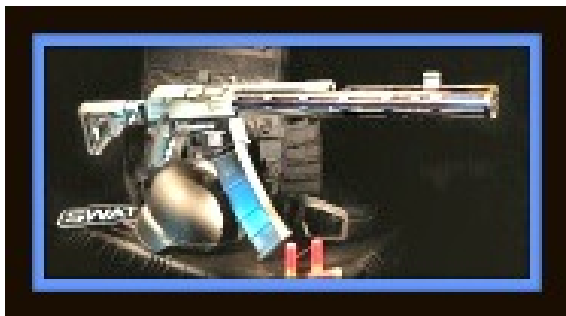
## ARPC 65th Anniversary 1911 Pistol - Available Soon

By the end of July we hope to have the Albany Rifle and Pistol Club 65<sup>th</sup> Anniversary 1911 pistol available for members to order. This special handgun is the Remington R1 enhanced 1911 semi-automatic in 45 caliber made in the USA. We understand that Remington quit producing 1911 handguns after WWII and has just recently started producing them again.



Special features include black oxide finish, lowered ejection port, extended beavertail, competition hammer, adjustable rear sights, fiber optic front sight, adjustable trigger and two eight round magazines. Each gun will have special Albany Rifle and Pistol Club 65<sup>th</sup> Anniversary medals in the grips and a lifetime replacement. ARPC member cost - \$800 plus firearm transfer.
