A Better Way to Shoot Handguns

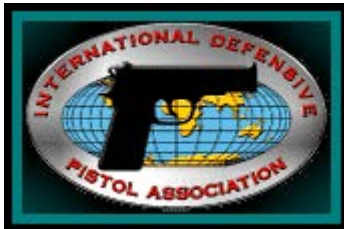
