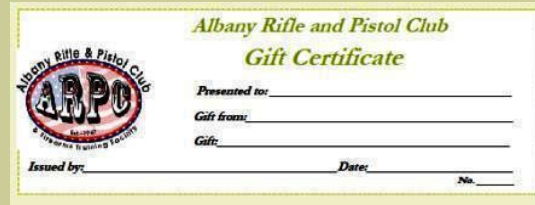

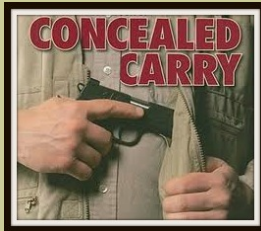

OREGON CONCEALED HANDGUN CLASS

Carry your handgun concealed, legally. Carrying a handgun is like wearing a seat belt in your car, you are not looking for an accident but should one come your way, you have a measure of protection. You do not want to shoot someone but if you have no other way out then carrying a concealed handgun gives you an option. Class includes firearm safety, use of force statutes, where you cannot carry and much more. Next class date is Wednesday evening, December 19th, 2012.

HANDGUN CARTRIDGE RELOADING

Would you like to purchase handgun ammunition for \$6.50 a box of 50? Learn how to reload handgun cartridges and save money on your ammunition. This class includes classroom information on how to reload handgun cartridges, the Lee Pro 1000 reloading press and all components (brass, powder, primers) for 250 rounds of ammunition.

This is a hands-on class where students set up / tune their new reloading press and reload / test fire ammunition. Class date is Saturday, December 29th, 2012.



BUILD YOUR OWN AR-15 CLASS

New Firearm Background Check...One Day Record!

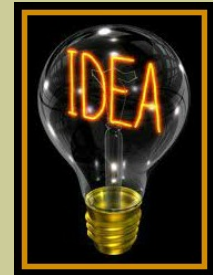


A [new single-day record](#) for point-of-sale background checks was established on Black Friday, Nov. 23, 2012, when 154,873 were conducted by the FBI National Instant Criminal Background Check System (NICS). That total was nearly 20 percent more than the previous high of 129,166 set on Black Friday last year. 6987 Because a federal background check is mandatory for every firearm sold at retail, background check activity serves as an indicator of retail gun sales. "Responsible firearms ownership is popular, mainstream and growing," said NSSF President and CEO Steve Sanetti.

ARPC Annual Meeting Update

The ARPC Annual Meeting took place on Tuesday, November 20th this year. Close to 200 club members and friends attended. The new Club Executive Board was elected, projects completed in 2012 were reviewed, shooting discipline reports were given and 15 door prizes (including 5 firearms) were won by club members. A Henry .22 caliber lever action rifle was raffled off, raising over \$900 for the club's junior program.
