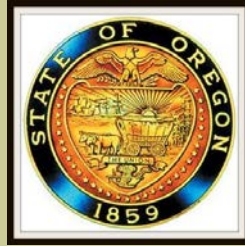

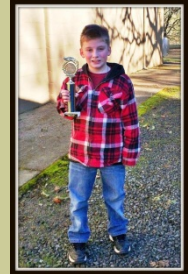
## Junior Update
