

Range Safety



The weather is improving and it is always more fun to shoot when the temperature is warm and the sun is out. Always keep safety as the first priority in your shooting fun. Here are a couple of areas of concern at the club that you need to be aware of as summer approaches.

Shooting at reactive steel targets is always fun. You hear the ring and depending on the target, you see it move. Not to mention that

you don't have to worry about taping up the holes. However, there is a problem with shooting at steel targets. Bullets have a tendency to separate when hitting steel and bullet fragments fly around. Please make sure everyone in or near one of our steel shooting areas is wearing safety glasses and aware of the potential danger. The main range steel plate has been repaired and back in place at the 200yd line. 7746 The club is also adding more steel targets on the main, north and east ranges for your shooting fun.

Exploding targets are not allowed on any shooting range at Albany Rifle and Pistol Club without Executive Board approval.

Range Officers

We want to take the time to thank all the range officers who are patrolling the club during weekends and busy times. Range officers, on duty, are there to assist club members and their guests while they are on the range. In addition, it is necessary to remind people about club rules when there is a problem.

ARPC is wholly owned by the membership. That makes all club members owners as well as members. It is our responsibility as owners to follow the rules and encourage others to do the same. You do not have to be a range officer to remind other shooters about club rules especially if they are doing something against the rules. Here is a helpful hint; don't try to correct someone on the range with a chip on your shoulder, they might have a gun in their hand. Remind people of the rules in the same way you would like to be reminded if you were breaking a rule.
