NRA Rules Govern, Match is the PRONE Position  
.22 Cal Rimfire Rifle. Metallic or Scope Category  
Entry Fee: Individual: 10.00, Team: 20.00 per Team

Awards in Metallic and Scope, in both Individual and 4-Person Team. NRA classifications will not be used. **INDIVIDUAL:** Shooters will be divided according to age categories: Sub Jr., Intermediate Junior, Junior, Prime (ages 21-30), Sub-Senior (ages 41-50), Senior (ages 51-60) and Experienced (ages 61+). Each category must have at least two shooters; those without this minimum will be combined with other categories. **TEAM:** scores will be combined from the already fired scores. Must declare Team Members prior to the start of shooting.

Course of Fire:

- 1) Dewar Course: 20 shots at 50 yards, A-23 target; 20 shots at 100 yards, A-25 target.
- 2) 40 Shots at 50 yards, A-23 target
- 3) 40 Shots at 100 yards, A-25 target
- 4) AGGREGATE OF ABOVE

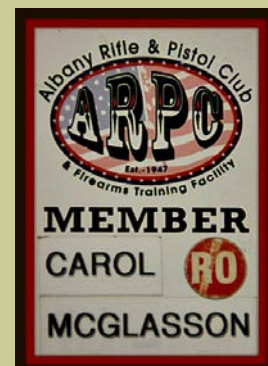
