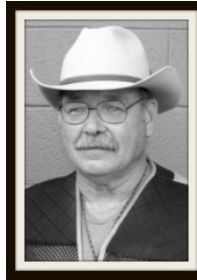
you took the RO class chances are that you are not a current Range Officer.

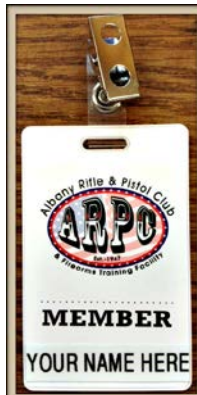
Main Range Targets

Please take the time to remove your targets after shooting on the main range. Always leave shooting areas in better shape than you find them. In addition, please remove any targets left up on the target boards by other members. 56154 Keeping this range clean is especially important as many hunters will be sighting in their rifles for hunting season.



Membership Renewal

The upgrade to our renewal system is almost finished and we are double checking each member's gate card to make sure it is turned 'ON', if the member is in good standing. A club member's gate card is turned 'OFF' if they are in arrears for more than 30 days. Please contact the club office if your gate card does not work. Sometimes we make a mistake, your membership has expired or the gate card is defective. We want to make sure your club membership status is correct.
