Main Range Cease-Fires



After everyone agrees to a cease-fire on the main range, make sure the safety area (between the yellow line and the red muzzle line) is clear of all shooters before pushing the button and going downrange. If you push the cease-fire button and immediately go downrange you may put yourself in front of people with firearms. Giving the shooters time to clear the safety around the shooting benches helps eliminate this potential problem. Always look both left and right before crossing the red muzzle line and going downrange.
