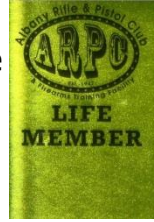

## Handgun Reloading Class

ARPC is holding a handgun caliber reloading class on Saturday January 25<sup>th</sup>, 2014 in the

Trap Range classroom from 9am to 1pm. This class covers handgun reloading theory, process, and hands on reloading of handgun cartridges. Estimated cost with the current cost of components to reload 9mm is 16¢, 40 cal is 19¢ and 45 cal is 22¢ a round. The class cost is \$320 which includes the class instruction, a Lee Pro 1000 progressive reloading press and all components for 250 rounds of ammunition.
