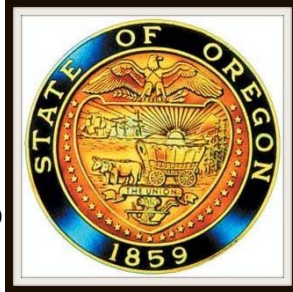

## Two New Gun Bills Officially Posted

Two new gun bills have just been officially posted on the Oregon Legislative website. Senate Bill 1551, requiring Oregon State transfers for private citizens when giving a firearm to a relative, and HB 4068 that allows people with convictions for small amounts of marijuana to apply for Oregon CHL's. We encourage all ARPC members to take a look at these new bills and contact the Senators or Representatives involved if you have concerns. Stay informed and involved with all legislation regarding ownership and use of firearms.

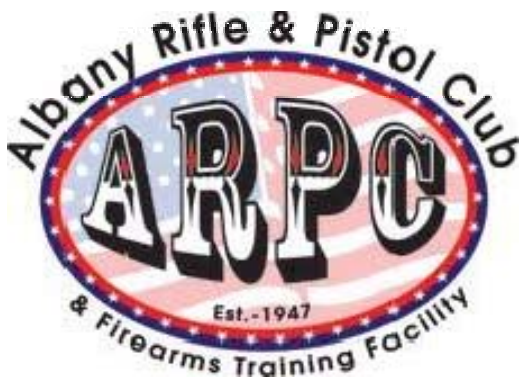
