ARPC Range Expansion Update

The biggest question we get from club members is "When is the 1,000 yard range going to be done?" We are moving forward with the necessary steps to get the 300, 600 and 1,000 yard ranges built. It sounds simple to do but it needs to be done right and most importantly SAFELY! The Executive Board and long range committee is working with an engineering firm to help design the ranges, drain fields, parking, impact / safety berms and environmental issues. Remember, the club pays for everything in advance. That means when the cash is available then the next step takes place.

Speaking of the next step... If you look at the overall plan to expand and make ARPC a better shooting facility then take note that the first major project of the expansion plan, other than purchasing land, has started. Ground prep is finished and construction of the new ARPC maintenance shop starts on April 1st (no fooling). The shop will provide the club with a long-overdue dry and secure place to store all of its maintenance equipment, building supplies, tractors, mowers and sorely needed storage.

Federal Firearm License (FFL) Issue

We have received a warning that some folks are stealing Federal Firearm Licenses (FFL) and modifying them for their own use. You must supply a copy of a federal firearm license for shipping purposes when purchasing a firearm online or by phone. If you want to ship a firearm to ARPC you need to have a copy of our FFL. There are two ways to get it; one - pick up a hard copy at the Pro Shop or two - go to the 'members' area of the ARPC website and download an electronic copy. The Pro Shop does not send the FFL to sellers on your behalf.



Using The 'Members Only' Area

Albany Rifle and Pistol Club has set up a 'members only' area to provide a secure place for member only information. You must sign up ahead of time to gain access to this area and that may take 24 to 48 hours, so don't wait until you need members only information before signing up. 19521 The 'members' only site, at this time, has your ARPC account information, renewal information, ARPC FFL and Indoor Range Safety Program.

All fields are for "primary" account information.
