## Message From The Board

Hello fellow ARPC members,

As some of you have heard, ARPC paid for a shot making machine earlier this year. In the interest of keeping members informed about unusual events, it was felt all of you deserved an explanation. This was not a Board approved purchase but after reviewing all available options the Board completed payment on the machine. While at first impressions this machine might sound like a good idea there are many reasons for ARPC not to utilize it. First and foremost ARPC is a club for both sport shooting and a firearms training facility. We are not in the manufacturing business. As a shooting range, there is an EPA Best Practices manual designed specifically to assist ranges in dealing with range concerns. As long as we stay within the "shooting range" parameters we have clear guidelines. It is unclear what all the consequences of a secondary smelting operation would be. In order to utilize this machine there are a series of processes that must occur. Here are a few of them discovered in a cursory search

1. Lead recovery- something we will pursue sometime in the future and this falls under normal range practices.
2. Scrap lead storage- once mined it becomes regulated
3. Specialized buildings for smelting and shot producing.
4. A secondary smelting operation to separate lead, dirt, jacketing material, etc.- an operation

that would fall under DEQ and OSHA jurisdiction.

5. OSHA requirements for employees and buildings appear to be extensive.
6. Hardness testing and blending other metals into the molten lead to create the proper lead hardness for shot.
7. Utilize the machine to make shot.
8. Buy and incorporate a bagging system
9. Build storage for completed product

The cost in infrastructure and other considerations outweigh the amount spent to date and put ARPC under unwanted scrutiny. Purchasing the proper lead from outside sources is cost prohibitive.

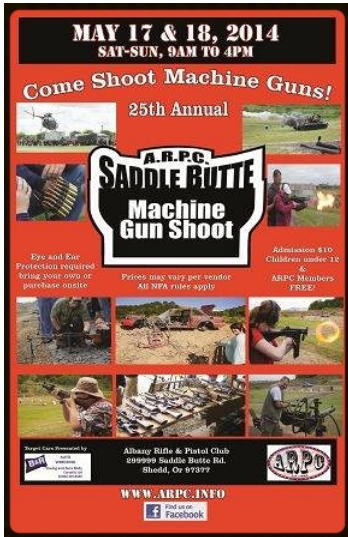
As has been discussed at the Annual meeting and in Newsletters, we are in the beginning phase of a major range expansion. We have spent the last year discussing and refining this plan by both committee and the Board. Money would be diverted from our 300, 600 and 1,000 yard ranges to start a secondary smelting operation. To delay this expansion that was a well thought out team effort to start a costly, unplanned and unapproved endeavor would be a failure of the Board to follow the ARPC Constitution. It states the Board's duties are to "have general supervision, control of all activities, and the financial responsibility for ARPC." Please realize the entire Board is committed to what is best for ARPC. The Board is looking for a well suited home for the shot machine. This Board of volunteers has spent hundreds of hours dealing with this distraction that should have been devoted to improving ARPC. As a member how can you help? By attending meetings you can help prevent rumors and be a well-informed ARPC member. We also need committee members throughout the year to keep ARPC growing. It is now okay to use steel core / steel jacket ammunition on all ARPC shooting ranges. 21221 Please make sure all rifle rounds stay within the regular bullet impact areas on the main range. Bullets striking rocks in the grass areas of Saddle Butte, in the summer, can create sparks that start fires.

## What's Up?

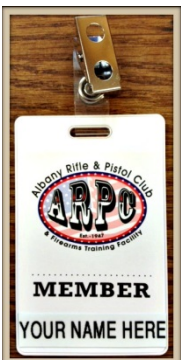
