Straw Purchase Ruling



On Monday, June 16, the U.S. Supreme Court in a 5-4 ruling allows strict enforcement of the federal ban on "straw purchases," or one person buying a gun for another. In a nutshell, this case stemmed from someone buying a gun for a relative and then turning around and selling it to said relative. Though both were legally able to own a firearm, the act of lying on a federal form constitutes a crime.

The federal law on background checks requires FFL holders, like ARPC, to verify the identity of buyers and submit their names to a federal database in order to eliminate persons with a felony record, under indictment, a history of mental illness, court ordered restraining orders and others barred from gun ownership. This check also alerts the transferor if the firearm has been reported stolen. In the State of Oregon, this procedure is accomplished by an approval through Oregon State Police Firearms Unit.

Firearm Transaction Record Form 4473 and identification procedures make clear that only the actual buyers are eligible to make the purchase. It features question number 11.a.: "Are you the actual transferee/buyer of the firearm(s) listed on this form?" And in bold print: **"Warning: You are not the actual buyer if you are acquiring the firearm(s) on behalf of another person. If you are not the actual buyer, the dealer cannot transfer the firearm(s) to you."**

Albany Rifle and Pistol Club abides by all state and federal laws involving firearm transfers. If you would like to transfer a firearm to a private party, we are happy to supply the State of Oregon "Blue Transfer Form" to you free of charge.

Three easy stages of fire, no movement, no holsters or magazine pouches required and shoot as often as you want Saturday or Sunday. Fun side matches, FREE lunch to each competitor (11am to 2pm) and a chance to win a gun and prizes provided by Glock. There will also be a Glock armorer on site to inspect your gun and repair any problems at no cost to you (minor repairs).

Animals on The Range

At times you may see deer, turkeys, rabbits, skunks or other animals on ARPC property near shooting areas.

Please stop shooting if you see an animal in or around your bullet impact area and wait until it clears the area. Don't shoot at an



animal to scare it away. When you shoot at or near an animal it is considered 'hunting' and we do not allow hunting on ARPC property. In addition, immediately call a 'cease-fire' if you see someone on either one of the Saddle Butte hills and as soon as possible report it to a range officer, if one is on duty, or call one of the emergency numbers listed at every shooting range.

Is Powder in Short Supply?

Black Powder Survival
