Range Courtesy and Safety

When shooting on the Main Range, try not to shoot someone else's targets. Many rifle shooters are trying to get the best shot group possible and extra holes from another shooter can get frustrating. Please remember to take all of your targets down after shooting even if they are still good. Leave every range in better shape than you found it always applies at all ARPC shooting ranges including the Main Range.

Also, please do not allow anyone to climb on berms between shooting bays. This includes setting up targets at the far end of shooting bays on the impact bank. If a person is visible from another shooting bay they are in imminent danger.

Basic Handgun Class

Basic Handgun Class on Wednesday evening August 20th at 6pm in Bay 6. This class will cover handgun safety, handgun knowledge / care, how to shoot a handgun safely and a small amount of shooting.

3) 1911A1 SPRINGFIELD ARMORY - \$3500 obo, FIRST EVER USPSA COMMEMORATIVE PISTOL FROM OLD DOMINION ENGRAVERS.....May be only commemorative ever issued for USPSA??, NIB, 24k GOLD PLATING OF USPSA LOGO, LEGEND, AND ACTION SHOOTER, HOGUE MONOGRIPS , HIGH POLISH BLUING ON SLIDE, ELECTROLESS NICKEL ON FRAME ASSEMBLY, SPRINGFIELD ARMORY ADJUSTABLE SIGHTS, HAND ENGRAVING EMBELLISHMENT, WALNUT DISPLAY CASE, LETTER OF AUTHENTICITY, MAGAZINE; FRONT SIGHT (The Official Journal of the United States Practical Shooters Association/IPSC) SEPTEMBER/OCTOBER 1992 Volume 9, Number 5, HISTORY...as communicated in a letter by David Stanford, President of USPSA at the time this gun was offered to members. "...this gun is so rare you will not find it listed in many, if any books. The gun should have considerable collector value NIB as this was the first gun that USPSA was to have offered in their name as a commemorative. Unfortunately Old Dominion ran into financial problems due to a labor dispute with their employees, before this program got off the ground. I estimate that there were fewer than 12 of these firearms ever made. In fact Old Dominion lost most of their employees and the guns were being produced singly by one or two men. In conversation with a Mr. Reece at Springfield I was informed that they supplied only about 6 firearms to Old Dominion before the problems arose."
