Firearm safety begins with you and is not only important at the shooting range, it should be the same at home, on your person and in your vehicle.

## Linn County 2nd Amendment Resolution

On February 24, 2015, the Linn County Commissioners (Roger Nyquist, John Lindsey, Will Tucker) approved a 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment Resolution to the Oregon State Legislature. John Lindsay said "There are a number of bills in the Legislature that would force counties to enforce gun control regulations," Lindsey said. "The state is trying to make counties enforce legislation that will undoubtedly be declared unconstitutional when challenged." Lindsey said the commissioners signed the resolution, "because we want to make it clear that we won't be a party to this." In addition, Linn County Sheriff, Bruce Riley signed on with the county commissioners. 8082 If you have an opportunity to thank the Linn County Commissioners or Sheriff Riley, please do so. They are trying to protect our 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment rights.
