## ARPC Range Rule Change



Safety is first, last and always at Albany Rifle and Pistol Club. Range rules continue to change as needed in order to maintain firearm safety at the club. Just to put the rumors to rest...this rule was NOT put into effect because of any accident or incident. We run an extremely safety conscious range and just want to keep it that way. Effective immediately "All firearms will be cased and uncased on the firing line with the muzzle facing downrange. Any uncased firearm must be carried muzzle up." This range rule is in effect on the main range, indoor range, north and east ranges.

ARPC is wholly owned by the club membership and firearm safety is everyone's responsibility. If you see a safety issue, take the time to talk to the person creating it, don't just walk away and let it go - discuss it. Firearm safety begins with you and is not only important at the shooting range; it should be the same at home, on your person and in your vehicle.

## Training Tragedy

Tuesday March 10<sup>th</sup> a Blackhawk Helicopter crashed in the waters off the Florida coast. All eleven on Board were killed. The four Louisiana National Guard crewmen were: Chief Warrant Officer George Wayne Griffin Jr. of Delhi, 37, Chief Warrant Officer George David Strother of Alexandria, 44, Staff Sgt. Lance Bergeron, 40, of Thibodaux and Staff Sgt. Thomas Florich, Fairfax, Virginia. The seven Marines were 26-year-old Staff Sgt. Andrew Seif, who had been awarded one of the military's highest honors for heroism only days earlier. Staff Sgt. Marcus Bawol, 27, of Warren, Michigan; Staff Sgt. Kerry Michael Kemp, 27, of Port Washington, Wisconsin; Capt. Stanford H. Shaw, III, 31, from Basking Ridge, New Jersey; Master Sgt. Thomas A. Saunders, 33, from Williamsburg, Virginia; Staff Sgt. Trevor P. Blaylock, 29, from Lake

## Oregon Legislature and Gun

### Laws

The Oregon Legislature will be introducing more firearm related bills this year. Please stay alert to new bills and voice your opinion to your representatives. You don't have to add anything more than "I'm in favor" or "I'm against" in your conversation with them. Most of the time an administrative assistant will be handling the comments and they only keep track of the 'yes' or 'no' counts. Go to Oregon Firearm Federation's website, click on 'Alerts', if you want to keep an eye on legislative issues. Look how some State Senators are racing to pass Senate Bill 941, a bill similar to the recent firearm transfer bill that was passed in Washington State.

Also the Oregon Legislature is considering Senate Bill 525 that would make it easier for police to confiscate guns in cases of domestic violence and suspected domestic violence. An existing federal law bars people from having guns if they are convicted of domestic violence or subject to a restraining order, but only federal agents can enforce that law. The new bill, SB 525, gives local law enforcement the authority to confiscate the guns. Though this bill sounds good, it doesn't actually stop anyone from what they are intending. It only addresses firearms and ammunition. They don't address using any other forms of violence; people who intend to do harm will always figure out a way.
