ARPC Annual Meeting

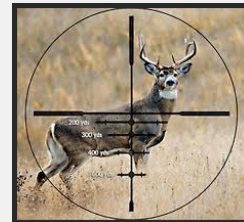

ARPC Executive Board Positions

The ARPC Annual Meeting on Wednesday, November 11th, is fast approaching and there are three Board positions open for election; Secretary, Chief Instructor and Executive Officer. The term will be for two years. These

positions are open to all members in good standing. As you are probably aware, ARPC has grown significantly over the last ten years. With that growth, ARPC has experienced some growing pains and dedicated Board members are needed to ensure club business is treated in the same manner as any successful business. ARPC's future depends on the decisions made by the Board as well as our employees. Our current President has a Business Management background and our Treasurer is a CPA. Range Rules

There have been some questions surrounding two of our Range Rules. Please read below for clarity.

New Range Rule:

Our new range rule states "All firearms will be uncased and cased on the firing line with the muzzle facing downrange. Any uncased rifle must be carried with the muzzle up." 8959 This does not mean that all firearms must be cased when on the range. Uncased rifles can be carried, muzzle up, into the main range when the range is hot.

Cold Range:

Albany Rifle and Pistol Club is a 'cold range'. That means all firearms brought onto the club property, except for concealed carry, must be unloaded. Even open carried handguns fall under this rule. Our range mirrors Oregon statute which define a loaded firearm as: "A breech-loading firearm in which there is an unexpended cartridge or shell in or attached to the firearm including but not limited to, in a chamber, magazine or clip which is attached to the firearm."
