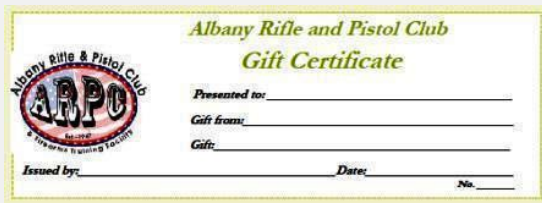
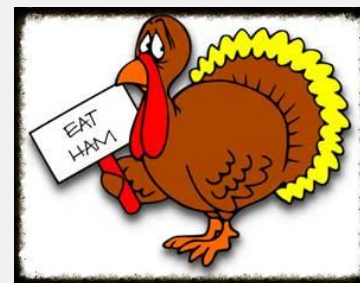

'Over the Log' Turkey Shoot

ARPC will host an 'Over the Log' black powder rifle turkey shoot on Friday, November 27th from 9am to 12noon on the main range. The main range will be open for regular shooting by club members during this event. The Turkey Shoot is open to all club members, the public and visitors. Competitors can use percussion, flintlock and inline black powder rifles of any caliber but must use iron sights - no optic sights allowed. This is a 50 yard match where competitors shoot 5 shots at the National Muzzle Loading 'X' target per round. The cost is \$2 per round of shooting and a total of four rounds in the shoot. The shortest distance from all 5 shots to the center of the 'X', measured with a string, wins the round and a turkey. Competitors are limited to one turkey and a special prize of a ham to one competitor who completes all four rounds with the shortest overall distance.
