Oregon Anti-Gun Bill

Oregon Firearms Federation (OFF) called it "one of the most dangerous pieces of anti-gun legislation we have ever seen."

The Oregon Senate Judiciary Committee is introducing a bill "LC 250 (temporary #)" for the upcoming short legislative session.

In brief - A "reporter" (defined as physician, a healthcare provider, a licensed mental health professional, an educator or principal or school employee who has had direct contact with the person, the person's employer, or a family member of the person) can make an anonymous phone call to the Department of State Police Firearms Unit that a person is experiencing a mental health emergency and poses a danger to self or others with a firearm.

Once the report has been received by police, the bill directs that "the department shall ensure that a firearms purchase hold record is created that prevents the person [from] purchasing] a firearm for a period of 30 days." You are required to petition for relief of the firearm hold in the circuit court in your county of residence or you can obtain health care provider documentation that you are not a danger to self or others. Also the "reporter" is immune from civil liability for making the report as long as the report is made in good faith. A draft of this bill is linked below.

While it is important to notify the proper authorities about someone who is a danger to themselves or others, this proposed bill goes far beyond common sense. Take a look at it; anonymous accuser or "reporter", no burden of proof required, no notification required to the accused, guilty until proven innocent. Contact your state Senator and let them know this will not improve public safety. Think about the next possible step, you are accused of having a mental health emergency and they remove all of your guns?
