Spotlight on Shooting Sports

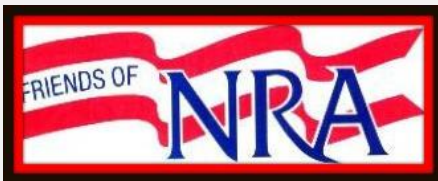
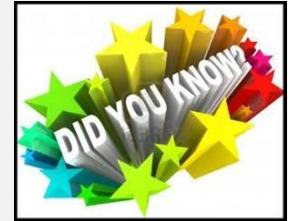
Black powder muzzle loading shooting is one of the fastest growing shooting sports at ARPC. Black powder muzzle loading guns are very accurate and extremely easy to shoot. Stop and think about it, powder, primer, patch and ball then pull the trigger. Yes, no cartridges to reload and almost as much fun as the 4th of July. Muzzle loading guns do not kick hard and often shoot groups under three inches at 50+ yards. Come on out on the first Sunday of each month to learn how to shoot a muzzle loader, they will even provide the gun and all components. The muzzle loading group has special guns for juniors and is trying to start a muzzle loading junior team. Full Auto Shooting Hours

There are specific days and times for full auto (all calibers) shooting on **ALL** ARPC shooting ranges. Full auto firing is permitted only on:

- Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays between 10am and 4pm.
- Second and fifth Sundays and the first, third and fourth Saturdays of each month between 10am and 4pm.
 - During club scheduled full auto events.

Always check the day and time when shooting full auto firearms at ARPC and stay within the allowed times.
