# Happy Independence Day



### West and Southwest Range Construction Begins June 27, 2016

As mentioned in the last two newsletters, construction starts Monday, June 27, 2016. The Main Range and Trap Range will be closed to shooting with the **exception of Fridays from 6PM-9PM, Saturdays 8AM-8PM and Sundays 8AM-8PM**. This project is expected to last 60 days. Target stands and target sticks will be made available on the Main Range for anyone who would like to shoot during these limited non-construction hours.

### ODFW Pioneer License Changes

Oregon Department of Fish & Wildlife recently changed their Resident Pioneer License and it has a lot of guys hopping mad. In order to qualify for this license, Oregon Revised Statutes require that you be an Oregon resident for at least six (6) months immediately prior to applying for this license, will be 65 years of age or older this year, and that you have resided in Oregon for not less than 50 years prior to the date of application. Up until 2016, this license was free. It now costs \$6. Now we know that \$6 isn't a lot of money but it's the principle of the thing. 9597 So we thought you'd like to know the reasons why you have to pay for it. ODFW does not receive any Pittman-Robertson Act funds (benefiting state wildlife agencies for conservation efforts, hunter's education and shooting projects and programs) for free licenses as it does for regular licenses. For each of these people, the Department of Fish and Wildlife missed out on collecting \$14 in federal funds; \$7 for sport-fish restoration and \$7 for wildlife restoration. As such, ODFW was losing a considerable amount of money funding these licenses.

The \$6 is the minimum amount that they can charge for Pioneer licenses and still receive Pittman-Robertson Act funds. So take heart, your money is going for a good cause and it's still great recreation for only \$6.

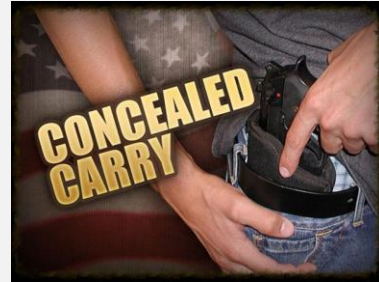


## Open Facilities Maintenance Position
