Honor Our Fallen This Memorial Day

Memorial Day is not to be confused with Veterans Day; Memorial Day is a day of remembering the men and women who *died* while in service of the United States of America while Veterans Day celebrates the service of all U.S. military veterans.

Memorial Day, originally called Decoration Day, was borne out of the Civil War and a desire to honor our dead. It was officially proclaimed on 5 May 1868 by General John Logan, national commander of the Grand Army of the Republic. "The 30th of May, 1868, is designated for the purpose of strewing with flowers, or otherwise decorating the graves of comrades who died in defense of their country during the late rebellion, and whose bodies now lie in almost every city, village and hamlet churchyard in the land," he proclaimed. The date of Decoration Day, as he called it, was chosen because it wasn't the anniversary of any battle.

Please take the time to honor the service and reflect on the ultimate sacrifice of their lives that these brave people gave for our freedom. The National Moment of Remembrance encourages all Americans to pause wherever they are at 3 p.m. local time on Memorial Day for a minute of silence to remember and honor those who have died in service to our nation.

Loaded Firearms on The Range

ARPC has three major safety rules:


- 1 - Always keep your firearm pointed in a safe direction
- 2 - Always keep your finger off the trigger until you're ready to shoot
- 3 - Always keep your firearm unloaded until ready to shoot

What does #3 really mean? Heck, I'm home and heading to the range so I am ready to shoot, right? Nope. If you are not preparing to shoot, actively shooting at, or getting your sights on your target, your firearm must be unloaded. Please do not adjust your sights or scope, lay your firearm down or rack it without completely emptying it and leaving the action open. Leaving a hot firearm unattended is a recipe for disaster. Please think of your safety, your family's safety and the safety of your fellow ARPC members.

Bay Setup vs Discipline Use

So, it's a nice Saturday afternoon, you just loaded up some ammo and want to go to the range to shoot. Great idea! You look at the calendar and USPSA has a few bays reserved until 4pm. Score...it's 5pm and they're all done. So you get there and three bays (the good ones that you like best) are still set up. What?! Why?!

USPSA and Multi-Gun Disciplines share stages as a labor saving program.
