### Oregon Firearms Federation REPEAL SB719

Republican House members Bill Post and Mike Nearman along with 2016 House candidate Teri Grier filed Referendum 302 last week with the Oregon Secretary of State's office. Termed the "Say No to 719" initiative, it aims to repeal SB719.

This controversial new law, SB719 which was signed into law last week by Gov. Kate Brown and named the Extreme Risk Protection Order law, allows individuals to ask a judge in a civil court to bar the subject of such an order from possessing or buying firearms or ammo for one year. It forces confiscation of property by the police with NO DUE PROCESS.

## Hunter Sight-In Days (HSID) September 2,3,9,10,16 &17, 2017

Hunting season is quickly approaching! Time to break out your favorite rifles and get them ready for the various seasons. ARPC is here to help. The first three weekends in September, ARPC will offer structured rifle sighting assistance on our Main Range. Experienced volunteers will assist members and non-members adjust their sights to make the perfect shot. 9547 This service is free of charge to ARPC members and \$5 per rifle for non- members. This community service is always appreciated by everyone who attends.

The logistics for all three weekends are as follows:

The Main Range will be controlled by HSID staff from 8:00 AM until approximately 4:30 PM. The Main Range will be closed from 8:00 AM until 9:00 AM for setup. HSID staff will use the north half of the Main Range. At 9:00 AM our volunteers will open shooting on the Main Range. The south half of the range will open for regular member use at this time; targets will be provided at this south end on the 100 yard line for our members. Cease fire calls will be under the control of HSID staff only and will be called at least every two hours for target replacement. At approximately 4:00 PM, HSID staff will call a cease fire and take down their target boards. The Main Range will then return to normal operating procedures for the remainder of each day.

As ARPC members, you will experience some inconveniences during these weekends. Please be courteous and patient. This is not only a community service but also a fundraiser. We will try to maintain normal shooting as much as possible.

## Justice Department Terminates and Repudiates 'Operation Choke Point'



This week the Department of Justice made clear that the Obama Administration's attack on the gun industry using the banking system - better known as Operation Choke Point - is over. In a [strongly-worded letter](#) to U.S. House Judiciary Committee Chairman Bob Goodlatte (R-Va.) dated August 16, Assistant Attorney General Stephen E. Boyd assured the chairman that the operation has been terminated and that "it will not be undertaken again."

Initiated in 2013 and involving the Justice Department and the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, Operation Choke Point sought to deter banks from conducting business with companies that engaged in commerce that the Obama administration viewed as undesirable. 44167 To do this, the Obama administration categorized certain types of businesses as being "associated with high-risk activity" in a banking guidance document used by the FDIC. Some of the types of businesses targeted by the operation were engaged in illegal or fraudulent activity, like "On-line Gambling" or "Ponzi Schemes." However, also targeted in this operation were legal businesses that engaged in lawful commerce such as "Tobacco Sales," "Coin Dealers," "Ammunition Sales," and "Firearms Sales."
