



Chief Instructor Candidate

Dear ARPC Members -

My name is Wayne Floyd and I currently serve on the ARPC Executive Board as the Interim Chief Instructor. I was asked to fill that role in June due to an Executive Board member resignation. The two year term Chief Instructor position is open for election this November. I am running for that position and would appreciate your vote.

The Chief Instructor's primary responsibilities are range safety and firearms training. My priorities while serving the club these last few months has been "Safety First" and developing additional firearms training. Working with our club managers (Carol and Brian), The Executive Board, and other ARPC volunteers we have revamped the New Member Orientation with a focus toward understanding the Range Rules and demonstrating safe firearms handling procedures. We have updated our Range Safety Officer training program to focus on Range Safety and Member Education. We also started development of a curriculum of basic firearms training programs. Our first course Basic Handgun Safety (geared to the new shooter), will be scheduled in early 2018. We hope to roll out additional firearms courses over the next year. Our ARPC firearms training courses will be offered for free to members and the general public or at the lowest cost we can make them. I am also working with 4-H to bring new opportunities for our young shooters and their families.

If elected to this position I will continue to focus on making ARPC a safe and fun place to shoot, for you, your family, and future generations. Thank you again for your consideration and your vote.

Main Range Safety

We see members who show up only once a year to sight in their rifles for hunting season and many of them do not remember the rules. Please gently remind them to case and uncase on the firing line and to check with everyone prior to hitting the cease fire button!



Basic Handgun Course

The ARPC is offering a Basic Handgun Course intended for new shooters, new members or anyone wishing to refresh their handgun knowledge. This course is also open to the public. Instructors are ARPC Range Safety Officers and the curriculum is patterned after the NRA course. 6366 This is not a concealed carry license class.

Instruction is free as is the use of our firearms; though to cover costs of ammunition we charge \$20 cash per person at the event. However, you may bring your own handgun with factory ammunition. We expect each participant to fire around 50 to 100 rounds. This is a two-hour class, with the first hour of instruction in a classroom, followed by an hour of hands on live fire in Bay 3.

We will review:

- Safety rules
- Storage and transportation of firearms
- Discuss handgun types
- Magazines and loaders
- Ammunition choices
- The use of handgun sights
- What to expect at the range
- Range commands
- The five items you need at the range besides the firearm
- The seven fundamentals of shooting
- Shooting positions
- Common shooting errors
- Cleaning your gun

Future training opportunities will also be explored. The second Sunday of each month is reserved from 1-3pm starting on December 10, 2017. This class has limited attendance but will be repeated monthly. For questions and to sign up please contact Jim at jim6br@gmail.com.
