Basic Beginning Handgun Course

ARPC is offering a basic BEGINNING handgun course intended for people over age 18 who have had little, if any, previous firearm training.

This course is also open to the public.

Instructors are ARPC Range Safety Officers and the curriculum is patterned after the NRA Beginning Handgun Course. This is not a concealed carry license class. 20185 Instruction is free as is the use of our firearms; though to cover costs of ammunition we charge \$20 cash per person at the event. However, you may bring your own handgun with factory ammunition. We expect each participant to fire around 50 to 100 rounds. This is a 2.5-3 hour class, with classroom and live fire instruction.



We will review:

- Safety rules
- Storage and transportation of firearms
- Discuss handgun types
- Magazines and loaders
- Ammunition choices
- The use of handgun sights
- What to expect at the range
- Range commands
- The five items you need at the range besides the firearm
- The seven fundamentals of shooting
- Shooting positions
- Common shooting errors
- Cleaning your gun

The first Sunday of most months are reserved from 12:30-3:30pm with the next available class on February 4, 2018. This class has limited attendance but will be repeated monthly. For questions and to sign up please contact Jim Gallant at jim6br@gmail.com.



ARPC Range Safety Officers

Who are these people I see at ARPC in the Yellow or Orange Vests?

If you visit ARPC on weekends to shoot you may have seen people walking around in orange or yellow safety vests with the words "Range Officer" or "RSO" printed on the back of the vest and wondered who they were and what they did. These folks are ARPC's Range Safety Officers. They are members like you that volunteer to work six hour shifts on weekends to help make the club a safer place to shoot.

The mission of our RSO Program is to educate, as necessary, all members and guests in firearms safety and range etiquette and to enforce ARPC range rules. They accomplish this by making rounds throughout ARPC during their shift monitoring all shooting activities with an eye toward firearms safety and range etiquette.

What can you expect from an encounter with an RSO?

The vast majority of encounters will be nothing more than the RSO entering a bay or range where you are shooting and at an appropriate time introducing themselves, checking for member/guest badges, observing for a few minutes, then leaving.

If during the encounter they observe a safety or rules issue they will call a ceasefire, pull the member(s) aside, and in a tactful manner explain the situation and what needs to be done to correct it.

If the unsafe condition is serious enough the RSO will obtain your name and member info off your gate card badge and pass that information along with a report on the encounter to the Range Manager and myself for review.

So hopefully you understand a little more about our RSO Program and will support the program and our endeavor to continue to make ARPC a safe place to shoot.

Hunting the Pests of the Pivots This Spring?

For those of us that enjoy helping out our friendly alfalfa growers, April and May cannot come soon enough. Sage rats, squeaks, whistle pigs, pot-guts and ground squirrels, whatever your preferred name for them, decimate alfalfa crops in Oregon,

California, Idaho, Utah and Washington. They can eat 14.5 pounds of alfalfa in a four-month period causing up to 45% loss of crop according to the OSU Extension Service. Their burrows cause water loss, weaken dams and increase erosion. It's a team effort to eradicate these buggers. Everyone has their favorite rifle of choice with the .17 HMR, .22LR, .204 Ruger and .223 Remington with a high-magnifying scope topping the lists. 7022 Make sure you follow all of the hunting rules of your chosen grounds, obtain permission and treat the landowner's property with respect while you're there. You'll have a place to shoot for years to come.
