Oregon's Gun Ban Initiative (IP43) Update

On Wednesday, June 27, 2018, the Oregon Supreme Court rejected the use of terms such as "assault weapons" and "large capacity magazines", noting that these terms in the proposed ballot title by the Oregon Attorney General misled voters.

Pursuant to Oregon law, the Attorney General has five business days to file a modified ballot title with the Oregon Supreme Court and serve copies of it to the petitioners (NRA, Oregon Hunters Assoc., Oregon Firearms Federation, etc.) who legally challenged the title.

These petitioners then have five business days to file an objection to the Attorney General's modified ballot title. The deadline for initiative proponents to submit signatures to qualify the initiative is July 6th, and they are unable to gather these signatures until the ballot title is certified. Therefore, the time is not sufficient to re-establish the initiative by the deadline.

If you hear anyone who is disappointed that this initiative failed, please try to dispel their fears and inform them about semi-automatic firearms; they only fire one shot per action of the trigger and have been available for over a century. Invite them out to the range as your guest for an informative day of shooting. You may just turn their opinions around.

Oregon 4-H Shooting Sports Competition Recap

Oregon 4-H Shooting Sports State Championships were held for the eighth straight year at ARPC, June 18th through the 20th, 2018. Youngsters under age 19 and numbering 307, accompanied by their parents, traveled from all over Oregon to participate in archery target and 3-D shooting, hunting skills, muzzleloading, pistols, rifles, shotgun and western heritage. 4-H concentrates on teaching young people competent levels of marksmanship and not so much focus on scoring. With over 3000 young people in Oregon in a local 4-H club, ARPC is honored to donate our range and time to this worthwhile organization. We also want to thank our volunteers for helping keep the children and their parents safe while they were on ARPC property and to our membership for working around the crowds.

The archery range is now open and it is splendid! The new backboards utilizing two layers of horse stall mat are working out great. Bring all of your friends to try it out. Keep an eye out for an article to come in late summer regarding the new known-distance archery range.

Disallowed Steel Targets

A member brought this target to our range, shot it with a rifle and then left it on the bay where other members and guests could have shot at it. This is a mild steel (steel that contains a low amount of carbon making it too soft in structure to shoot) target and is a very dangerous action for several reasons:



- First - mild steel craters very easy and a bullet that strikes a crater cannot dissipate its energy in a normal fashion. This can cause the entire bullet to reverse course back toward the shooter and anyone else in the area.
- Second - shooting any steel target at under 100 yards with a rifle is not only dangerous but against ARPC Range Rules.

Abandoning this target at ARPC is against our Range Rules and was very thoughtless since other members might have assumed this was an ARPC target, potentially shooting at it and endangering all people in the vicinity.

If you brought this target to the range, please do not bring another mild steel target. Under Article Three of the ARPC Constitution all members are required to "promptly report to the Club officers any infractions of rules by members or visitors which may create an unsafe condition or reflect poorly on ARPC". If you witness someone bring an unsafe target to ARPC, please ask them to remove it and report their name to either Wayne FLoyd, our Chief Instructor at atci@arpc.info or Brian Boesch, Range Manager at rm@arpc.info. We strive to keep our range as safe as possible, but we need extra eyes and ears to do so.



ARPC Range Safety Officers

Last year, ARPC recognized a few flaws in our Range Officer Program. A safety program must concentrate on keeping everyone from being harmed in any way. The previous RO program concentrated more on friendliness than mitigating safety infractions. So, our Range Manager and Chief Instructor went about redefining and retraining for this position, modeling it after the NRA Range Safety Officer (RSO) program; incorporating much of their instruction. This new program is not without its hurdles, however it has made the range much safer than ever. Members and guests are starting to respond positively to the appearance of RSOs in the bays and on the range. Every program has its growing pains and trust that we're addressing all of your concerns. If you see a RSO come in to your shooting

bay please say hello and remember they're just another member like you. Understand that he or she is there for your safety and to assist you when needed.
