Bays 8-12 now have gutters on the shooting side to keep you a bit drier. This project is finished for the season but will continue as soon as the ground dries come next summer. Thanks to all of the members and guests who had to drive around the excavator, skid steer, truck with dump bed, etc. while staff worked to make the range better for all of us.

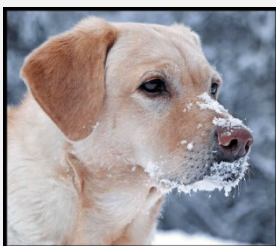
