Hunter Safety Education Courses

ARPC is proud to be a part of Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's (ODFW) Hunter Safety Education Program. In Oregon, a Hunter Education course is required for all new hunters age 17 and younger unless hunting on land owned by a parent or legal guardian, or unless participating in the Mentored Youth Hunter Program. This course provides a thorough introduction to the skills hunters need, such as firearm safety, hunter ethics, wildlife identification and hunt preparation.

We also recommend Hunter Education for any adult new to hunting, or as a refresher for experienced hunters. Some nearby states also require every hunter in their state to have completed Hunter Education. Make sure to verify the requirements before you make the trip.
