As ARPC is member-owned, we will never enter into a financial agreement that would indebt our membership. We only proceed with a project when funds are available.

As this project started to come to fruition, we realized that it would cost upwards of \$1.5M. That, in itself, was a bitter pill to swallow. However, it was coupled by the realization that the land that was to be used for this project has a gas pipeline easement. 6040 When asked if we would be able to place a dirt bullet retention berm over it, the owners were quick to use the word "litigate".

The long-awaited arrival of range brass barrels is finally here! Bays 8-12 have now been outfitted with 55-gallon brass barrels. Similar barrels are found in all shooting areas and are intended for your range brass and dud rounds.

Remember to pick up your brass and always leave the range in better shape than you found it. 12605 And remember that you are welcome to pick up other people's brass that they have left behind for your own uses. It's the polite thing to do and your fellow members will thank you for it.

We Love Steel Targets

Steel targets are perfect for the instant gratification of a well-placed shot! However, steel also has an inherent safety issue. Splatter can bounce off in any direction



and has the potential to strike the shooter or anyone in the area. This potential problem is intensified if the steel has deep pits in it. ARPC supplied

steel is monitored and replaced as needed. In spite of this there have been members and guests struck by projectile fragments in spite of our diligent maintenance.

Please consider the increased risk involved when you shoot at steel targets. Wear wrap around safety glasses to increase your eye protection. We strive to keep our range as safe as possible but please keep in mind that if you shoot steel targets you will experience splatter striking your person at some time.
