#### We Shall Honor the Fallen



Memorial Day is a federal holiday for remembering and honoring people who died while serving in the United States Armed Forces. This year, it is celebrated on Monday, May 27th. In addition to Memorial Day, June 6th, 2019 marks the 75th Anniversary of D-Day. The D-Day Memorial's motto in Bedford, Virginia states our sentiments best, "Commemorating Their Valor, Fidelity, and Sacrifice". The youngest D-Day veterans are now in their mid-90s; it won't be long until the last of them are gone. Please educate your family about this day in World War II. The invasion of Normandy, France was one of the largest amphibious military assaults in history. It resulted in the Allied liberation of Western Europe from Nazi Germany's control.

## Oregon Legislature Anti-Gun Bills Senate Bill 978 - NOT MOVING FORWARD!

Thirteen Oregon Senators refused to participate in floor sessions for days until SB 978 was withdrawn. On May 13, 2019, their efforts rewarded all of us as the Oregon Senate Leadership agreed that antigun legislation, including SB 978, is defeated, at least for this year. 17885 A potential ballot initiative may be introduced in 2020 and they're already working on more gun bills for next year.

THANK YOU to all of our members who attended the numerous rallies and contacted their legislators to help defeat these bills. We must all remain vigilant against these attacks on our gun rights.
