2019 Oregon State USPSA Championship Match

ARPC is hosting the 2019 Oregon State USPSA Championship Match Friday-Sunday, August 9-11, 2019. This match also counts as the Columbia-Cascade Section Championship for the 2018-2019 Points Series. This is a Level II USPSA Major Match with 11 stages plus Chronograph with a minimum of 276 rounds required. We will be following the [2019 USPSA Competition Rules](#). The Appendices cover the different division requirements, and equipment will be checked.

There has been a tremendous response by sponsors, with prizes and in-kind match support donations exceeding \$45,000. Prizes will be awarded randomly, and there will be a drawing for several custom Springfield-Armory pistols, with customization work performed by Springer Precision out of Redmond, OR.

Sign-ups are online at Practiscore.com and must be entered by August 2nd, 2019. The match fee is \$175 and there are 20 spots remaining in the event.

Here is the registration link, you have to sign up for an account on [Practiscore](#) (free). Match shirts are available to order from [TechwearUSA](#). You can choose between two colors, and two styles in each color.

There will be a steel shoot-off immediately following the match during the mandatory 1-hour scoring protest period. This will be cash-entry (\$10), with cash-payout single-elimination bracket with a maximum of 32 competitors.

Immediately following the shoot-off, we'll do awards (plaques), and drawing for firearms and select other prizes not randomly awarded. Everyone will go home with something, not including the various hats, stickers, t-shirts, and other swag donated by sponsors.

Hunter Sight-in Days September 14,15,21 & 22, 2019

Hunting season is rapidly approaching! Time to break out your favorite rifles and get them ready for the various seasons. ARPC is here to help. The second and third weekend in September, ARPC will offer structured rifle sighting assistance on our Main Range. Experienced volunteers will assist members and non-members adjust their sights to make the perfect shot. This service is free of charge to ARPC members and \$5 per rifle for non-members. This community service is always appreciated by everyone who attends.

The logistics for both weekends is as follows:

The Main Range will be controlled by HSID staff from 8:00 AM until approximately 4:30 PM. The Main Range will be closed from 8:00 AM until 9:00 AM for setup. HSID staff will use the north half of the Main Range. At 9:00 AM our volunteers will open shooting on the Main Range. The south half of the range will open for regular member use at this time; targets will be provided at this south end on the 100-yard line for our members. Cease fire calls will be under the control of HSID staff only and will be called at least every two hours for target replacement. At approximately 4:00 PM, HSID staff will call a cease fire and take down their target boards. The Main Range will then return to normal operating procedures for the remainder of each day.

As ARPC members, you will experience some inconveniences during these weekends. Please be courteous and patient. This is not only a community service but also a fundraiser. We will try to maintain normal shooting as much as possible.

Sportsman's Warehouse will be onsite on Sept. 14th with a variety of products. They are also donating a pair of Vortex Diamondback binos! We will give each HSID participant, that pays to sight in their rifle, a ticket for the drawing. Winner will be drawn after the second Sunday.
