Wondering About the Current Range Projects?

This summer we accomplished some much needed maintenance and updates around the range. We repaired dry rot damage and replaced the siding on the Clubhouse. We updated the HVAC system and added commercial entry doors. We added a new entrance to the Indoor Range so we could use the Clubhouse as a backup training classroom when the North Range Classroom is in use. We corrected serious drainage issues and replaced concrete to make our range easier to use. We increased the height of several berms on the North and East range to reduce splatter between bays. We are adding lighting to Bays 1 and 6 that will no longer require quarters. ARPC members have access to all of the Executive Board Meeting Minutes that include the approved range projects and funding amounts on the member side of the website.

Full Auto Zombie Apocalypse

For those who don't have a Full Auto firearm but would like to compete there will be 10 slots with a loaner SMG, bring your ammo. We will also run in semi-auto PCC with one stage including a "battle field" pickup SMG during the match. Come join in the fun.
