







MEET THE RSO- A MONTHLY SEGMENT TO GET TO KNOW A LITTLE BIT ABOUT OUR GREAT VOLUNTEER RANGE SAFETY OFFICERS



NEW ARPC RSO MANAGER LOUIS THELAN

Louis Thelan has taken over the RSO Manager job replacing Michael Ditlefsen. Special thanks to the years of dedication that Michael devoted to this position. Michael helped develop this position and has made the program very successful. Louis is a RSO and recently retired. He volunteered to step up and run the program. When you see Louis on the range please thank him for helping keep ARPC a safe and fun place to shoot! Here is Louis' story:

I have lived all my life in the Willamette Valley but my wife and I moved to Shedd over ten years ago. I first learned of the Albany Rifle and Pistol Club through our next door neighbor Jan who took me out to the club to let me try his firearms (it sure is nice having a great neighbor like Jan and his family, by he way). At age 58, I bought my first firearm at the September 2009 ARPC gun show and joined the club so I could have a safe place to learn and shoot my firearms. I attended classes, got my concealed carry permit, enjoyed the events offered by the club and volunteered at the next gun show and machine gun shoot.

I have always enjoyed volunteering at ARPC as it's a great way to contribute to the

club and save a bit on dues but did not consider becoming a Range Officer until I had more experience handling firearms. Around six years ago I started volunteering at the Hunter's Sight In event that happens every September as well as applying for and becoming a Range Officer. 7706 I now supervise the Hunter's Sight In and continue to volunteer as a Range Safety Officer.

MEET THE RSO- RON STEAGALL

My name is Ron Steagall. I started shooting small bore rifle competition in 1965 by a invitation from a friend at OSU. I joined ARPC in early 80's and started shooting high-power rifle competition. I started working in the RO program hoping to make the range safer, educate members in safe weapon handling on and off the range. Over the years the RO program has greatly improved to what it is today.

From the Chief Instructor

As many of you may know, we have a dedicated group of volunteers serving as range safety officers. Not only do they serve a minimum of four 6 hour shifts a year, but after each shift they complete a report which we use to determine how the club and it's membership are doing regarding safety. Also, most of the RSO's have now completed a thorough Trauma/1st Aid course and are now certified in First Aid. When analyzing the data from their reports, we are finding that the most common problem areas arise from members inviting guests to use our range. One of our most reported violations are from guests not signed in properly. Last year we had almost 8,000 guests signed in. This means we most likely had in excess of 10,000 guests at ARPC last year. Signing our liability waiver is extremely important when we have so many visitors. So I thought I would remind everyone about our current guest policy. We believe that the fewer rules the better, but that means the ones we have need to be respected. When there is a report of a rule violation, there is an investigation which may result with anywhere from a gentle reminder to being asked to take the new member orientation or even losing club membership. We think that we have a generous guest policy, and one that is easy to understand. There is not a limit to either the number of guests per member visit, nor the number of times a member can bring a guest. The requirements are straight forward, only two guests may be shooting per every hosting member, and the member may not be shooting with them, as they are to be actively supervising their guests. Guests cannot be left alone while on ARPC property. We also require that each guest is signed in, and has a name sticker that is visible. Signing in may be a good time for the member to review the range rules with their guests, as the rules are posted nearby in the clubhouse, as well as each bay. Please be alert with all guests, as they may not be familiar with the range rules. We are hoping to see the number of violations concerning guests decrease, as all of us are responsible for our guests and their safety. Please continue to make our range a fun and safe place to shoot!
