Pro Shop/Office

The office and Pro Shop are open 10 to 5 Monday thru Saturday. Please only one person in the Pro Shop at a time. We are out of primers. Powder is trickling in. Bullets are almost out of stock, but we did just receive some 9mm 115 FMJ full metal and 124 JHP bullets in. We have daily limits on these items and are reordering as product becomes available. All popular reloading components are very hard to obtain so expect shortages. Please be patient with your fellow members as we all adjust through the new year and remember to observe social distancing guidelines while visiting the range.

Message from Chief Instructor

It is spring again and reflecting upon the last year we have seen and lived through unprecedented times. Yet, ARPC has been able to remain open for members to enjoy. Our COVID policy is compliant with the state's directives. Our disciplines and classes are running, with a few modifications. The RSO's remain our best program to maintain a safe and enjoyable shooting environment. As we review the data collected from our RSO program, there are still a few deficiencies. The rules that are most often not followed continue to be; failure to wear a member badge, failure to sign in a guest, and failure to always wear eye protection. We still see some issues with shooters

downrange when others are handling firearms at the bench. Bay 4 and 5 still see some people not reading/following the instructions on the signs. Remember, if you bring a guest, which is a valued privilege of membership, please sign them in, have them wear a name tag, and educate them regarding the rules. No more than 2 guests can shoot at a time and must be under the members supervision. Members can not shoot while their guests are on the line. Not properly monitoring your guests can affects your membership. As a member it is your duty to point out any unsafe conditions to other members and their guests, but please do so in a respectful manner. Anyone can call a emergency ceasefire, make the range cold, and request help. With many new shooters and new members, we need to continue to focus on safety first. If you have not been here for awhile, please review the rules before shooting. The RSO mission includes education, and documentation of infractions of the rules. It is up to the Executive Director, CI, and Executive Committee to evaluate and investigate all infractions that come to our attention. We have permanently barred individuals who have destroyed club property or acted in unsafe manners. Please help us to continue to provide a safe shooting environment by frequently reviewing the rules.

Basic High Power Rifle Class

Basic M1 Garand Class

High Power discipline is offering a basic M1 class May 22, 9am –2 pm. The class is intended for people new and unfamiliar to the rifle. The class will cover safety, basic inspection, maintenance and loading/shooting techniques for high power matches. Upon Completion of the course, ARPC members will have met the training and membership requirements to purchase a M1 Garand rifle from the Civilian Marksmanship Program. There will be three hours of instruction in the classroom followed by rifle handling and live fire on the range. Rifles and ammunition will be provided. The class fee is \$40. The fee will cover ammunition and raise funds for the ARPC Junior programs.
